## **ANZRSAI** Award for **Best Conference Paper**

The Australia and New Zealand Regional Science Association (ANZRSAI) will host its 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference on the RMIT University City Campus in Melbourne, 6-7 December 2021. The theme this year is "Risk! The Challenge of Managing Risks to Regional Futures".

At the conference, ANZRSAI will present an Award for the Best Conference Paper, sponsored by the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications. There is a small cash grant for the winner (\$500). To be eligible for this Award, the following conditions must be met:

- An abstract for the paper is submitted on-line by 27 September 2021.
- A copy of the full paper is sent to Professor Paul Dalziel by email at paul.dalziel@lincoln.ac.nz by 1 November 2021.
- The paper is presented at the conference by one of the authors.

The ANZRSAI Award for Best Conference Paper 2019 was awarded to Robert J Stimson and Alistair Robson for their paper "Endogenous Employment Performance of Non-Metropolitan Regions Across Australia 2006-16".
