The winning thesis will contain research with significance towards regional and urban problems or policy issues (*including Economics, Regional and Urban Studies, Geographical Science, Modelling, Demography, Transportation, Market Organisation, Resource Management, Environment, Tourism, Education, Sociology, Psychology or any other area of Social Science which contributes to the broad area of Regional Science Science*), and contribute to understanding regional structure and change.

The winner will receive expenses towards attendance at the Association's 2006 annual conference to take place at Beechworth, Victoria, between 26th – 29th September, 2006 where he/she will be expected to present a paper based on the thesis/project.
